The Inn's Mediterranean estate on 265-acres with gardens, fountains and outdoor sculptures has the only San Diego course to host both PGA and LPGA events. Par 72 will score a perfect round on the 18-hole Resort Course. Oaks North 27-hole executive course will require more bravado. Pre-play practice at the driving range may help. Post game dinner at El Bizcocho offers one of the most extensive collections of wine in California valued at more than \$1 million. If brewskies are more Dad's thing, the inn has a quintessential Father/Son bonding experience ... the What's Brewing Package. Chauffeured transportation takes lucky participants to Stone Brewing Company, Lost Abbey/Port Brewing and Iron Fist to quaff a few suds. Beer munchies, a vintage cigar box with a cigar, cutter and matches, as well as two-ounces of single malt scotch and a Rancho Bernardo Inn logoed flask round out the event. A much needed one-night accommodation is included, too...zzzz. (Room rate Father's Day weekend start at \$229. An 18-hole round of golf is \$89. What's Brewing Package \$209 without transportation, \$309 with transportation (suggested option, bail will be more expensive than the extra transportation cost).)
